## Code of Ethics

- Serve all as equal irrespective of nationality, sex, age, marital status, race, culture, creed, political views or social standing.
- Uphold with honour the teachings of Mikao Usui. The Usui System of Natural Healing.
- The member will at all times observe the client's personal boundaries.
- The member act in a professional manner.
- To ensure that any advertisement clearly state one's qualification e.g. Reiki Practitioner, 'The Usui System of Natural Healing', 'Usui Shiki Ryoho'.  
Advertising should not state or claims to be able to cure diseases.
- Not to discredit The Reiki Association of Australia Inc. by words or actions.
- The member will not offer medical diagnosis or interfere with the treatment of a licensed health provider.
- The member if required will refer client to appropriate qualified licensed health provider.
- Provide a safe, comfortable area and atmosphere for Reiki Healings.
- All client records are to be kept confidential.
- Abstain from the use of drugs and alcohol during all consultations.
- Will strive to promote and expand the understanding of Reiki into the community.
- Be honest in communication with clients and not mislead in anyway and or make false claims about the outcome of the Reiki treatment.
- To ensure that the client understands that all recommendations or advice offered is merely for consideration only, and that the client is free to decided their own actions.
- Member will demonstrate honesty at all times in representation of skills, knowledge and services provided.

## Practitioner Guidelines

- Maintain a high level of professional competence and development, always seeking to improve one's knowledge and skills.
- The role of the practitioner is to facilitate the health, healing and wellbeing of the client through a diverse use of information, resources and Reiki healing. For the purpose of treating the whole person body, mind and spirit.
- Member may request the presence of a parent/advocate when treating children.
- The Member will strive to embody the Principles of Reiki and endeavor through the vehicle of 'Hands on Healing' to empower clients.
- Qualified Practitioner Members will upkeep Annual membership of Personal Indemnity Insurance.
- Member will exhibit Reiki Qualifications and Current Membership Certificates of The Reiki Association of Australia Inc. at location of practice.
- Member shall provided a simple explanation of a Reiki Treatment at the client's initial session.
- Respect and honour all lineage's and healing modalities without prejudice.
- Member will not make improper use of clients information, status, finances or authority, to gain or seek a benefit or advantage for self.
- Member should seek to embody the qualities of honesty, truth, acceptance, forgiveness, compassion and tolerance.
- To encourage and empower the Client to take responsibility for their health and wellbeing
- The Member will refrain from personal judgment, beliefs and honour the individuals right to 'freedom of choice'. Listen with compassion, respect and never assuming to know what is right for another, only serving to raise their awareness.
- Member expresses genuine concern and interest towards client's.
